

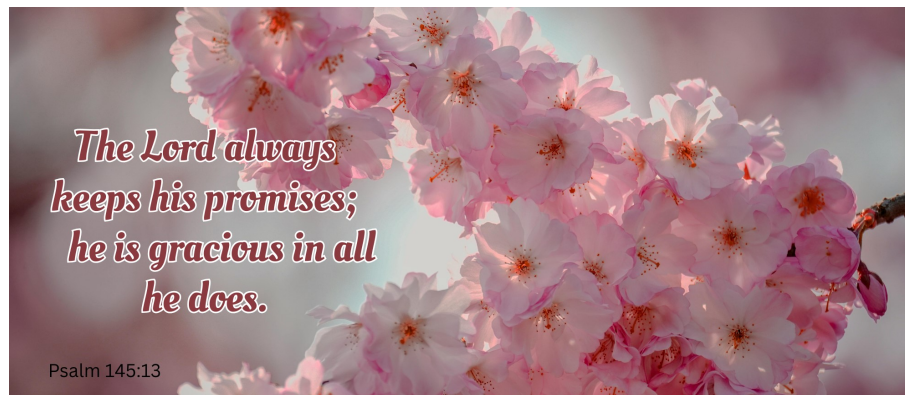

If needed, you should also find one on the ends of each row in the seat-back pockets.



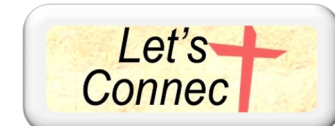

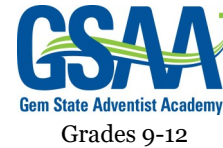
