





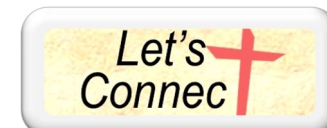

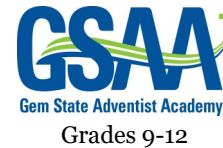
Grades K-8
