

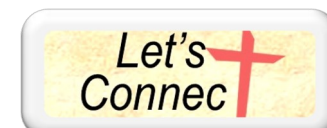

- 64 Clothing storage bins, \$8.00 ea

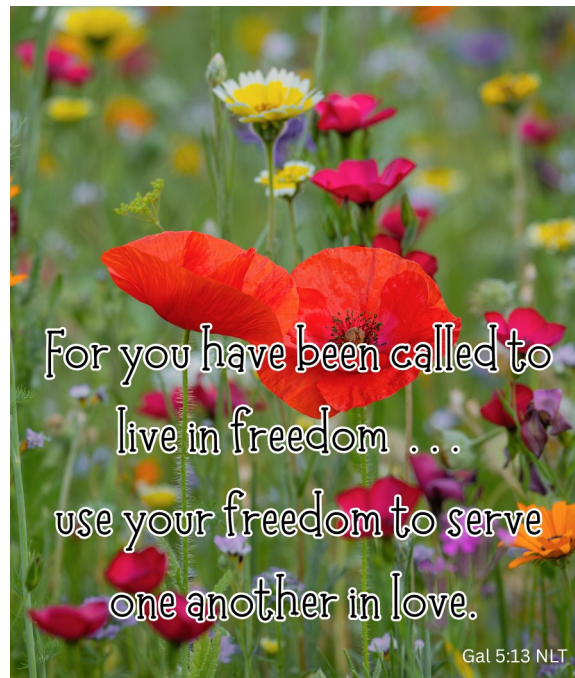
NOTE: if any area receives more donations than needed, we'll use the extra blessings to fund other needs in our ministry.

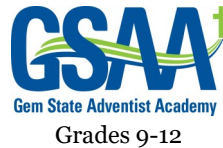
